1.0 INTRODUCTION

3.0 QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS/ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Interested and qualified Contractors wishing to carry out the project as described above will be required to submit the following documents:

- i. Evidence of Registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) with the inclusion of Certificate of Incorporation and Articles of Association.
- ii. Company Tax Clearance Certificate for the past three years (2015 - 2017)
- iii. Possession of experience as a Prime Contractor in at Least two (2) projects of similar nature and complexity with verifiable letters of contract award and certificate of job completion within the last Five (5) years.
- iv. Detailed Company profile and Organization structure including names and telephone numbers of key personnel (Technical/Managerial).
- v. Evidence of Financial capability. (Reference letter from reputable bank)
- vi. Copies of VAT Registration with Tin number and evidences of VAT remittances for the last 3 years (2015 - 2017).
- vii. A sworn affidavit that all documents submitted are genuine and verifiable.
- viii. Any additional information that may enhance your bid.

- ix. Registration with Lagos State Government in appropriate category
- x. Company's Audited Account for at least three years

4.0 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- i. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.
- ii. All claims must be adequately substantiated with documents and must be verifiable.
- iii. The Lagos State Judiciary shall deal directly with only the authorized officers of interested companies not with their agents.

2. The Bidding Documents must be accompanied by a bid security (original) obtained from a reputable bank or Insurance bond as indicated in the table above and as detailed in the Bidding document.
