INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT IN LAGOS COURT

Lagos State Ministry of Justice in pursuance of its mandate and in compliance with the requirement of the Lagos State Public Procurement Law 2011 (as amended in 2015), has secured approval to execute some capital projects as part of its statutory mandates and intends to apply part of it for Procurement of Works

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB), a procedure specified in the Lagos State Procurement Guidelines for Procurement of Works and Goods and is open to all bidders from eligible countries as defined in the Guidelines.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect Bidding Documents at the Procurement Unit, Lagos State Ministry of Justice, Block 2, The Secretariat, Alausa-Ikeja from 9.00am to 4.00pm; Monday to Friday.
5. **Qualification Requirements / Eligibility Criteria**
- (i) Evidence of Registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission including CAC certificate and Articles of Association.
 - (ii) Evidence of current and valid registration with Lagos State Public Procurement Agency with appropriate class
 - (iii) Current Tax Clearance Certificate of the Company and two Directors for the last three years (2017, 2018 & 2019)
 - (iv) Company Profile and Organization Structure with the CV of key personnel/support with professional certificates
 - (v) Availability (own/lease/hire) of the essential equipment as listed in the Bidding Data Sheet.
 - (vi) Experience as a Prime Contractor in at least Two (2) projects of similar nature and complexity with verifiable letter of Contract Award and Certificate of Job Completion within the last Five (5) years.

- (vi) Evidence of payment of 3 years Development Levy for at least 2 Directors. (2017, 2018 & 2019)
- (v) Evidence of Company's financial capability (submission of audited balance sheet or other financial statements for the last 3 years) and bank support. (2017, 2018, & 2019)
- (vi) Copies of VAT Registration with TIN number and evidence of VAT remittances for the last 3 years.
- (viii) A sworn affidavit that all documents submitted is genuine and verifiable
- (ix) Any additional information that may enhance your bid.

All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security of a reputable bank or Insurance Bid Bond @ 2% of Bid Price.
